USWCA Bonspiels:

The USWCA National Bonspiel will be held in Utica, NY from February 23–27, 2022. The Detroit Curling Club hosted a playdown on 11/22 to determine team priority to the bonspiel. Congratulations to Team Turbow: Melissa Turbow, Diana Jankowski, Stephanie Whitmore and Jenny Levy. Thank you to Julie Benson for organizing and running the playdown.

Also, the USWCA is hosting a 5 and under Open bonspiel which will be held at the Bowling Green CC January 14–16, 2022 and a 5 and under Women's bonspiel at the Waltham CC February 4–6, 2022. Visit the USWCA website for more information or contact Dawn Brauninger. Eligibility for all USWCA bonspiels will be determined by the status of curlers in the 2019–20 season.

The USWCA Circuit Event is designed to increase participation in women's bonspiels and increase the competitiveness of women curlers not currently participating in National Playdowns. Individual curlers register online through the USWCA website. The fee for a season is \$30. Curlers must have at least two (2) members of the Circuit on their team to accumulate points. The DCC Ladies International Bonspiel is a USWCA Circuit event.

Grass Roots Curling Support: The USWCA has a Gifts and Grants Fund to "promote women's and junior curling at a grassroots level by providing funding for special projects and programs". The Fund must be used by USWCA female members in good standing and junior curlers affiliated with a USWCA member club. 


