Pat was a fine curler, but really lit up the arena with his smile, his laugh, and a quick-witted comment. Pat was an active Sinner, a proud Killer Flamingo, and participated in the USSMCA National Senior Men's Curling Championships. Pat is survived by his wife Ann Gabhart, his four daughters, siblings and their families.

Due to the pandemic, we were not able to properly celebrate Pat's life. During his life, Pat was a runner. When he was not out there running, he could be found cheering on his friends and family from the sidelines. That was just how Pat was.

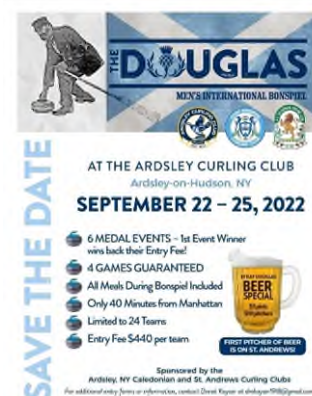

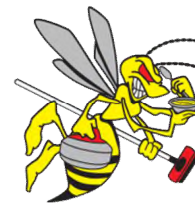

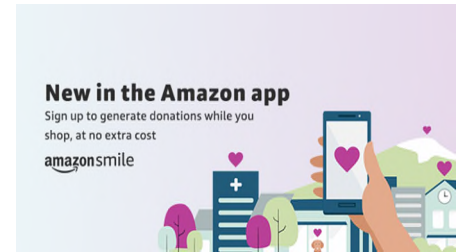
