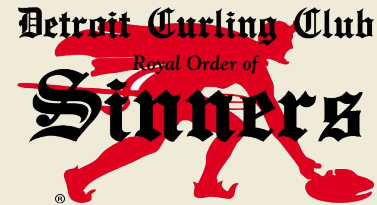

Detroit Racquet and Curling Club

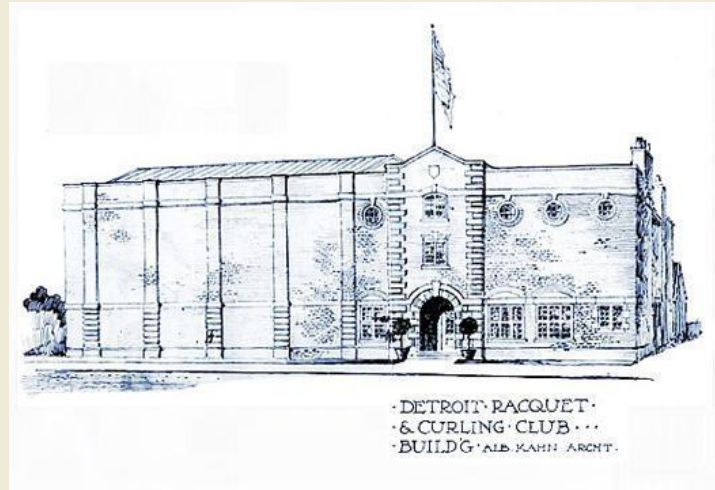
It is said that The Detroit Curling Club is the oldest sports club in the Detroit metro area. There were at least 5 curling clubs in Detroit before our club was formed in 1885 and there were a few after 1885 that have “come and gone”. One was The Detroit Racquet and Curling Club which was incorporated in 1902 and had an initial membership of 100 prominent Detroiters. They raised enough funds to hire the famous architect Albert Kahn to design and build a 3-story brick structure on Woodbridge Street in Detroit. In addition to club rooms and locker rooms, the building originally housed three squash courts, one racquets court and two curling rinks outside of the main structure (this was long before refrigerated ice making).

The clubhouse opened in 1903. The curlers of the club were actively involved in curling events with The Detroit Curling Club and The Windsor Curling Club. Though this only lasted until 1909 when they did not seem to have enough members interested in the sport of curling. They eventually dropped the word “curling” from their name, but I do not believe it was until the 1940s. The Racquets club is still in operation downtown and remains a rather exclusive club to join.

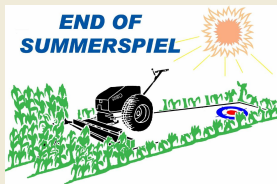


