Travel plans are currently being finalized, with the U.S. team set to depart from Newark, NJ on October 25 and return on November 15. Teams have been thoughtfully assembled to balance curling experience and regional representation, and many are already coordinating practice time ahead of their fall departure.

The Scot Tour is part of a rich tradition of exchange between the USWCA and the RCCC, dating back to 1955. These tours have long promoted international friendship and camaraderie, offering unforgettable experiences both on and off the ice. During the tour, the U.S. team will visit clubs throughout Scotland, competing in friendly matches and taking part in cultural exchanges.

We're proud to see Elizabeth carry on this legacy and represent both her club and country—what an amazing achievement!

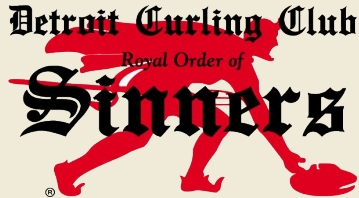

Curling Development Fund

The Detroit Curling Club (DCC), Rockettes Curling Development Fund (RCDF) provides funding to DCC curlers to support curling development or attend events which promote women's curling. Each year, the Rockettes board will dedicate a portion of funds raised to fund the following year. The amount will vary depending on the success of fundraising that year, other obligations, women's events and club events. Applicants may only be awarded a portion of funding requested. Applications are accepted for events that occur in the current fiscal year (May 1st to April 30th). Applications may be submitted at any time during the fiscal year in which the event occurs, but once the dedicated funds are assigned for the year, no further awards will be made.

Eligibility: Any individual, no matter age or gender, may apply for funding. The applicant must be a good standing member of the Detroit Curling Club. Social members are not eligible.
