His presence at the club is missed tremendously but his spirit is kept alive by those of us who knew him. Pat was an active Sinner, a proud Killer Flamingo, and participated in the USSMCA National Senior Men's Curling Championships.

We invite all DCC members, their friends and family to join Team Cannon's Curlers for a Cure for the 2026 Run the Ribbon 1 mile or 5k walk/run on June 21, 2026 at the Detroit Zoo. Lead by the fearless Pole, Mike Grudzinski, the group included DCC Members Mike & Katie Szatkowski, Kelly Munro, Laura Call, Yolanda Lewczuk, Bob Yarn, Charlie & Sue Race, Julia Ferry, Ela Majewski, Jacob & Jenna Podgorski, and guest, Tri Gaffney.

The travelers toured sites in and around Krakow, Warsaw and Katowice, including the Wielicka Salt Mine, Wawel Castle, the Warsaw Uprising Museum and Old Town in Warsaw.

The adventurers also took this opportunity to sample some very delicious Polish cuisine including multiple kinds of pierogi, gołąbki, golunka (Polish braised pork hock), roast duck and beef cheeks! But it didn't stop there, these globetrotters (as stuffed as they were) tore through Polish pastries, sweets and beer!!! 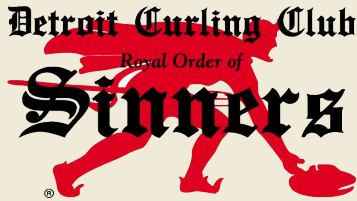
Everyone had an incredible time and we are already talking about what our next trip might be!!!

**Rockettes!!! Join us for a guided kayak tour of Detroit's historic east side, led by Rockettes Gabby Weiss and Ana Owens!**

When: Monday, June 15th, 7pm-9:30pm

Where: We'll meet up and depart from Detroit River Sports (14601 Riverside Blvd, Detroit, MI 48215) and enjoy the sights and sounds of the water. We'll spend most of our time learning about the history of the river and the Eastside Canals, visiting Greyhaven Island and the Historic Fisher Mansion along the way. We'll finish with a quiet paddle through the canals in southern Jefferson Chalmers.

What to bring: DRS will provide: your kayak, paddle, and life vest. We recommend bringing: a water bottle and sunglasses. Optional: a light snack and small towel (splashes happen!)

Experience level: Experience is helpful, but not required. The route length is 3 miles (around 90 minutes total) and includes ~10 minutes of paddling up river (against the current).

Weight Limit: 275lbs per passenger

Payment: \$25 per person. You can pay on the day of the tour by venmo, cash, or card.

As part of that commitment, we are sharing the SafeSport Code, updated for 2026. The Code applies to all Participants in the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Movement.

[Federal law](#) dictates the Center's authority and jurisdiction within the Movement. The Code was first introduced March 3, 2017 and is revised periodically.

As the New Year begins, we want to ensure that all USA Curling members are aware of it. [You can find the revised Code on our website.](#)

**NOTE:** As a reminder, all DCC board members, representatives, drawmasters, rental instructors, adaptive clinic instructors, junior instructors and juniors committee members must complete their SafeSport training each year. 


