REGISTRATION IS OPEN

League / Membership registration opened on August 29, 2026. Be on the lookout for more information over the next week or so. Remember, base USCA dues are included in your DCC membership. All you'll have to do is register as a DCC member and we'll take care of the rest. **Note:** if you are a competitive curler, their additional dues are your responsibility.

Lifetime Locker Program –

Sales for the Lifetime Locker Program will begin on August 29, 2026. The cost is \$500 for a single or \$1,000 for a double locker. The double lockers are double occupancy and will not be sold separately.

Current members with lockers will have first right of refusal to purchase their locker. After that, the program will open to all returning members. If any lockers remain after this purchase period, the remaining lockers will be offered to all returning members for \$20 for the 2026-2027 season. 8/25 Project AILSA Floor Update

Good things are happening with Project AILSA.

We are pleased to announce that the redline review of the Scope of Work between B32 Engineering and the Detroit Curling Club has been finalized. Over the next two months, the project team will work with B32 to finalize key design inputs and detailed requirements.

The project remains on schedule:

- Design: August-October 2026
- Contractor Bidding & Award: November 2026
- Material Procurement: November 2026-January 2027
- Construction: May-September 2027

We are also seeing a strong response to the capital campaign and would like to thank everyone who has already made a pledge. The committee is currently finalizing program details, including the structure and terms of the member bond offering. We are targeting an October launch and will share additional information as plans are finalized.

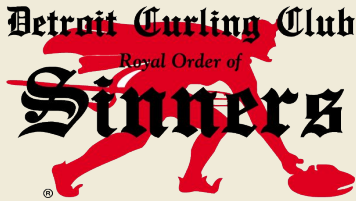

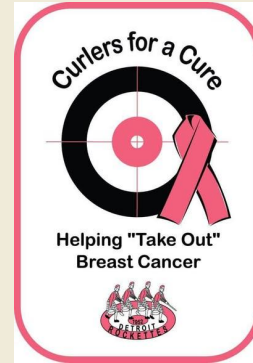
Curlers For a Cure invite all DCC members to help prevent breast cancer by participating in the annual Komen Walk.

Junior News

Changes to Juniors Curling Structure

Sundays

Our Sunday program will continue to be the primary practice for all junior athletes and will provide instruction and development across all skill and interest levels. Here is a breakdown of the Sunday

Juniors instruction schedule:

- **12:00-1:30 U18 Competitive Juniors**
 - This time is more focused and competitive in nature and will be reserved for athletes who are serious about improving their game and have an interest in competing. This is not based solely on current skill level. We are looking for kids who are engaged, willing to listen and learn, consistently put in the effort, and want to challenge themselves to become better curlers. Participation in this group is based on DCC Juniors Committee approval.
- **1:30-2:30 Little Rocks (Ages 6-10)**
 - This group will be for curlers who cannot yet throw full weight rocks down the full sheet. Practice time will include a variety of age appropriate, skill-based drills. We will also give the kids opportunities to put all their skills together in half sheet scrimmages.
- **2:30-4:00 Social Juniors**
 - Curlers move to Sunday Social when they can throw full weight rocks down the full sheet. This group is perfect for curlers who enjoy the game of curling and just want to have fun. This group is also designed for our younger curlers with a goal of competitive curling, but who may have a shorter attention span and need flexibility to move around and between activities. There will be a variety of drills and scrimmage opportunities each week.

We ask that all parents attend an orientation on the first Sunday practice.

- U18 Competitive and Social Parent/Child Orientation- November 1 at 2:00 PM

Wednesdays- Now U18 Competitive Juniors

This league will be an add on for an additional charge of \$100 and is based on DCC Junior Committee Approval.

Since this group is based on DCC Juniors Committee Approval, **please do not pay the extra \$100** until after our first Sunday practice and parent orientation on November 1. This will give us an opportunity to explain the expectations for Wednesdays and make sure the program is a good fit for each athlete. We may also reach out to some returning athletes ahead of time who we know are interested in competitive curling.

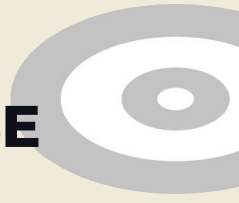
World Curling Mixed Doubles Qualification Event throughout the weekend
